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Choir Participation Agreement 2020

Dear Parent / Caregiver,

Congratulations! Your child has been invited to represent Seven Hills Public School in the School Choir for 2020. There is a limit of 20 students allowed to participate in the Blacktown Festival of Performing Arts so the first 20 students (from Years 3-6) to return the completed agreement form will be able to perform at Wyndham College in September.

At Seven Hills Public School, we believe that it is a privilege to represent our school in any way possible. The school expects that students value these opportunities with high regard and therefore, we are asking students to learn and understand our school community's expectations and values.

This participation agreement is with students who have been selected to represent Seven Hills Public School in the Choir. We ask that it is thoroughly read and discussed by students and parents/caregivers. It must be signed by the student and parent/caregiver, ***and returned to the School Office no later than Friday 28th February 2020***, to indicate that both parties clearly understand our expectations when students represent Seven Hills Public School, and agree to abide by them. Students **will not** be permitted to leave school grounds for participation in the Choir this year if the participation agreement is not signed by both the student and parent/caregiver.

Participation Agreement

I will:

- Be committed to attend weekly choir practices on ***Thursday mornings at 8am*** (at school).
- Be committed to attend 3 choir practices for the Blacktown Festival of Performing Arts.
- Purchase (if you don't already own) a BFoPA T-Shirt (cost approximately \$15). An order form will be sent home separately once the order information is known.
- Be committed to attend the Dress Rehearsal on 8th September 2020.
- Be committed to attending the Blacktown Festival of Performing Arts on Tuesday night 8th September 2020.
- Represent Seven Hills Public School to the best of my ability (displaying exemplary behaviour both at school and away when representing my school).
- Be committed to perform at school and community events such as Education Week and Presentation Day.

I understand that any breaches of this agreement may result in my child not being eligible to participate in the Choir. As a follow up, each student's agreement will be checked and additionally signed by their 2020 Choir Teacher, Mrs Sigg.
